Continue to support student learning by:

- Ensuring teachers have an in-depth knowledge of the Australian Curriculum for their students including the opportunity to moderate within our school and externally with local schools.

Support all staff with:

- Collection, interpretation and use of student's achievement data
- Identification of focussed and individual learning goals for students through a case management approach
- Utilising the school's pedagogical framework to support the teaching and learning process
- Authentic enactment of Australian Curriculum through a collegial coaching model (Sharratt and Fullen) to meet school wide targets.

Our initiatives include

Develop clear and consistent processes at Miriam Vale State School by:

- Providing targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum through both school and cluster moderation. (Sharrett Parameter 8)
- Revisiting, refining and/or revising the school pedagogical framework and embedding it as the shared language of teaching and learning.
- Provide time for staff to have professional conversations with teaching colleagues and leadership team focusing on literacy, including Early Start Assessments and the use of the Literacy Continuum, opportunities to monitor student progress and strategies for intervention. (Sharratt Parameter 6)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Ensuring smaller class numbers in the junior school by supplementing SBS resourcing to ensure a full-time teaching number (\$39000)
- Purchasing additional teacher aide/ Speech therapist time (\$33064)
- Provide release time for staff to complete collection of Early Start and analyse data to inform next steps in learning (\$5600)
- Provide professional development time for staff to monitor literacy, using the Literacy Continuum and supporting resources in addition to One School marker collection tool (\$2457)
